## Increase Nebraska's property tax credit

In this scenario, Nebraska would spend an additional \$154 million, which is close to the amount of revenue the state would gain under the sales tax base expansion we examined earlier in this series, on its Property tax credit Program. The program provides reimbursement for property taxes paid and is funded at a level set by the Nebraska Legislature, currently \$115 million per year. Income is not a factor in the credit and no assistance is offered to renters.
