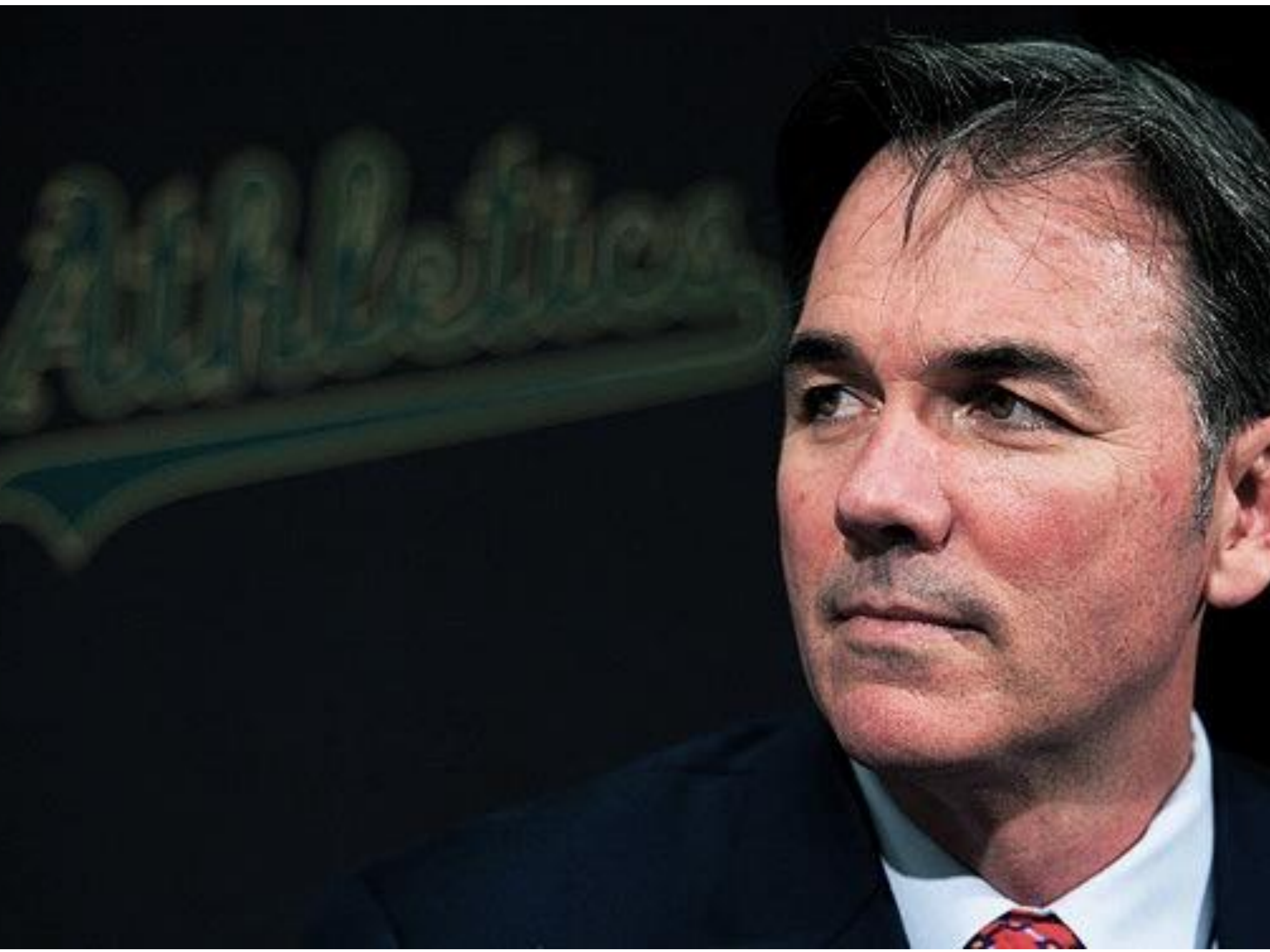

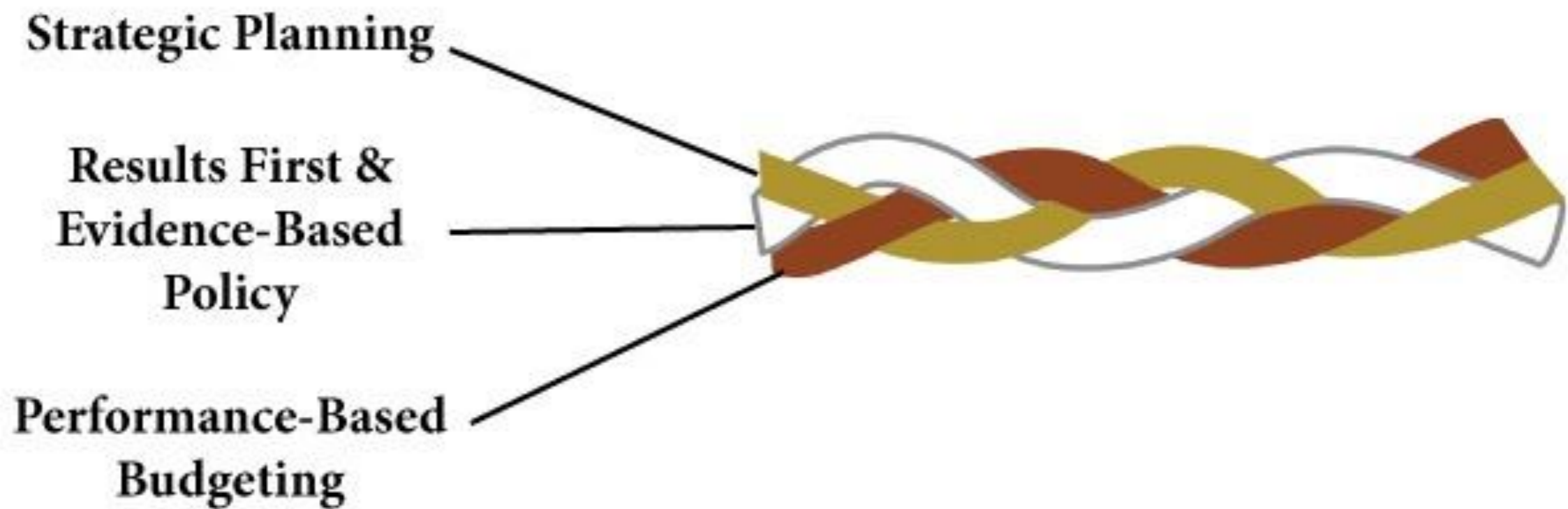
Mississippi

The New Reality

- **More mandates/cost of providing services shifting from federal government to states**
- **State budgets are volatile**
- **Demand for services outpaces available resources**
- **No built-in, ongoing feedback loop to evaluate existing investments**

Results First in Mississippi

- Program Inventory
- Evidence-Based/Research-Based/
Promising Practice Screening
- Current ROI vs. Expected ROI
- Report to Legislature
- Legislature Implements
Recommendations



Results First - Corrections

- Evaluated 19 intervention programs
 - 9 of 19 were evidence-based
 - 8 of those 9 were projected to have positive returns
 - 7 of those 8 were actually having consistent positive returns
- Alternatives
- 2015 Change - RID Program

Is there a needs assessment?

What's the program description?

Does it have an evidence/research foundation?

How will it be implemented?

How will you ensure fidelity to the evidence?

How will it be measured?

7 Elements of Quality Program Design

- Before the first dollar is appropriated, we know the expected return on investment
- Agencies alter behavior going forward
- Better decisions made, better outcomes achieved
