Nebraska's Entrepreneurial Programs: 1980 to Present

1985 - Governor Kerry's Policy Research Office released VC Study

- Venture Capital Network Act (1986)
 - \$25,000 in FY1987 and FY1988
- Nebraska Research and Development Authority (1986)
 - \$4 million, repealed in 1989

2002 – Nebraska Venture Capital Forum Act

• \$500,000 for three years, expired in 2005

2005 – Agricultural Opportunities and Value-Added Ag Partnership Grant Program

- \$3,158,064 in total funding, eliminated in 2011
- 8.75 FTEs \$14.90/hour

2006 – Building Entrepreneurial Communities Act

\$1,363,950 in total funding, eliminated in 2011

2007 – Nebraska Operational Assistance Act

\$250,000 per fiscal year



Business Financing Continuum




Outcomes & Metrics

- □ \$1 BIA Funding ——— \$5.12 private investment funding
- □ \$1 BIA Funding ———— \$2.32 revenue from sales
- □ 162 Direct Jobs Created \$50,617/Annual wage
- □ 307 Total Jobs Created → \$49,609/Annual wage
- ☐ State and local tax impact ——— \$1.22M Annually
